### Criteria:

- Graduating high school senior from Cedarcrest HS, Mount Si HS or Two Rivers School.
- Grade point of 3.0 or higher.
- Minimum Grade 8 refereeing certification with experience of at least one year officiating matches for SnVYSA district level teams.
- Essay of 250 words minimum addressing "How Officiating as a Youth Referee Has Affected My Life".

Applicants need to mail the following to SnVYSA **postmarked no later than April 30<sup>th</sup> each year:**

1. Essay (judged on content as well as grammar, spelling and punctuation).
2. A cover sheet showing name, address, phone, email.
3. A copy of student's transcript showing GPA.

Incomplete application packets will not be considered.
