Miscellaneous Information:	
Restart After Delay	IFK for team that had possession
Goal Scored	'ALL' of the ball crosses over 'ALL' of the line
Goal or Cone Knocked Over	No goal, restart with Corner Kick or Goal Kick
Offside	Indirect Free Kick for defending team
Non-penal fouls awarded an Indirect Free Kick; must touch another player before going into goal	Dangerous play, high kick, charging, impeding progress of a player, obstruction of goalkeeper, delay of game, unsporting behavior, slide tackling, pass back to goalkeeper
Penal fouls awarded a Direct Free Kick; can go directly into goal	Kicking, tripping, jumping at opponent, charging opponent in violent manner, charging from behind, striking a person, holding, pushing, handling the ball
Deliberate Heading	No heading allowed; IFK awarded at spot of offense; if in goal area ball moved to goal line and placed on spot nearest to point where infraction occurred
Build Out Line	hash line equidistant between top of penalty area and the halfway line

Number of Players	7 v 7
Substitutions	Any stoppage w/ referee permission
Referee	Self-assignment via SnVYSA
Asst Referees	Assigned to semi-final and final matches only
Match Duration	Two 20 minute halves
Scoring	Not on GK, throws, IFK, Kickoff
Deliberate Heading	None – award IFK
Slide Tackling	None – award IFK
Offside	Enforce - FIFA rule applies
Fouls/Misconduct	IFK or DFK - FIFA
Penalty Kick Mark	10 yards
Goal Size (feet)	Similar on all 7 fields
Goal Area (yards)	4 yards x 8 yards
Penalty Area (yds)	12 yards x 24 yards
Center Circle (radius)	8 yards
Throw-Ins	No retries
Goalkeeper	Yes
Advantage Rule	U9 – NO; U10 – begin to call
